

Celebrate the beginning of summer break by creating a mini piñata!



Gather Supplies:

You will need:

6 pieces of tissue paper

Tape

Candy

Confetti

2 ribbons

Scissors

Cardboard tube

Step 1:

Tape one of the ribbons to the end of the cardboard tube.



Step 2:

Stack all six pieces of tissue paper together, cut off a strip about 3 inches wide, and then fold them in half lengthwise.



Step 3:

Roll the stack of folded tissue paper around the tube once, then cut the strip so that it is just a bit longer than needed to wrap around the tube once.

Save the leftovers!



Step 4:

Take the ribbon on the bottom of the tube and lay it over the open end. Next cut a square from the leftover tissue paper and tape it over the ribbon and open end of the tube.



Step 5:

Load your tube up with candy and confetti! You can make confetti with the leftover pieces of tissue paper, just make sure to save a square for the next step!



Step 6:

Cut another square of tissue paper and cover the top opening of the cardboard tube. Tape the second ribbon to the top to make a hanging loop for the piñata.



Step 7:

Take your folded stack of tissue paper and cut it on the open side about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way toward the fold.



Step 8:

Separate the strips of tissue paper and start wrapping them around the cardboard tube, beginning at the bottom.



Step 9:

After each strip of paper is attached to the tube, fluff the fringe out. Now it's time to hang up your piñata and pull the bottom string!



Step 10:

Now celebrate the beginning of summer break! Maybe you can make some piñatas for your friends. Enjoy!
