Climax: What is the most exciting and intense part of the story?

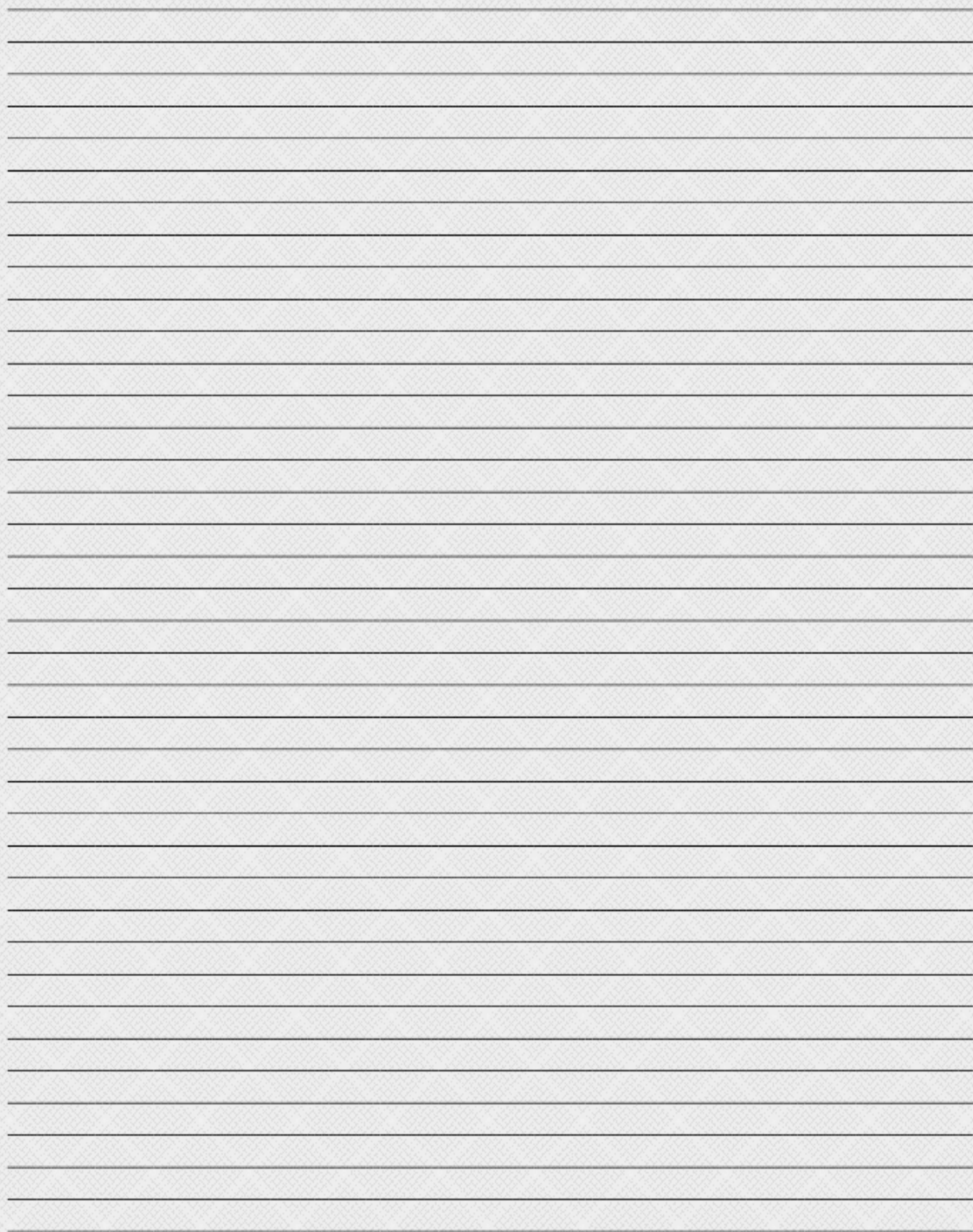
